Functionality

The BlackBerry Desktop Manager enables you to:

- Synchronize Appointments (only applicable for Colibri Basic users)
- Synchronize Contacts (only applicable for Colibri Basic users)
- Synchronize Tasks/Memos
- Backup handheld data
- Load new applications onto your BlackBerry handheld

Installation information

IMPORTANT: It is important to select the correct installation options when installing BlackBerry Desktop Manager software. Failure to do this **will affect the proper functioning of your BlackBerry handheld** (or any other device using the BlackBerry Connect software).

To install BlackBerry Desktop Manager software:

1. Insert the installation CD into the CD drive of your PC. The installation will start automatically.



If the installation process does not start automatically, open “Windows Explorer” and navigate to the CD drive. Double-click “setup.exe” to start the installation process.

2. Choose the country or region you are located in. Your system settings will be verified (this may take a minute).

3. Click “Next” to continue the installation process.

4. Accept the license agreement and click “Next” to continue the installation process.

5. Fill in your name and organization and click “Next” to continue the installation process.

6. Choose the installation location and click “Next” to continue the installation process.

7. Select the setup type (recommended: Typical) and click “Next” to continue.

8. Choose the integration type. Choose “**BlackBerry Internet Service**”.



Failing to choose the correct option here will cause your system to perform incorrectly.

9. Check the desired options for creating desktop shortcuts and click “Next” to continue the installation process.

10. Click “Install”.

11. The software will now be installed.

12. Click “Finish” to complete the installation process.
